## Measuring for your shade

## INSIDE MOUNT

Measure at the 6 positions shown (3 horizontal, 3 vertical) and record the smallest dimension as the 'Recess Size'. (e.g. in PIC 1 your width measurement will be 36" and your length measurement is $60^{\prime \prime}$ ). Provide the width measurement first. Note: A

## 1/2"deduction will be taken. DO NOT order with deduction.

## OUTSIDE MOUNT

Decide where the shade will be fitted outside of the window opening. Check for any obstructions such as a window sill or window handle. Start with the width and measure the area you want the shade to cover, we recommend an overlap of at least 4" on each side.

For the length measure at least 4" above and below the window (if space allows). Record both measurements and order an Exact fitting and we make the shade to fit the window area. (e.g. in PIC 2 width measurement will be $36^{\prime \prime}$ and length measurement will be 60 ").

## Measuring for your shade - Bay Windows

## ANGLED BAY WINDOWS

The trick to measuring angled bays is to make a template. Follow our step-by-step guide:

Step 1. Find the head rail depth of your chosen shade in the chart provided (please refer to the previous page "measuring your shades - Square Bay Windows").

Step 2. Place two pieces of paper together. Using the head rail depth as your measurement, mark each piece of paper with a line in the same position.

Step 3. Position your pieces of paper on the window sill and ensure both the line marks meet up as shown.

Step 4. Using a pencil, mark the window sill where the edge of the paper meets the sill.

Step 5. Do this for both corners of the bay.
Step 6. Measure between each section as shown below. This will determine the width of each shade needed. All shades should be ordered as exact. (A, B \& C measurements)

Step 7. For the length measure from where you want the top of the shade to be down to the sill or floor.


## TIP!

For both the width and length measurements, measure in three places for each window. For the width, measure top, middle and bottom and for the length measure left, middle and right. Your window might not be even, so always give us the smallest measurement.

## Measuring for your width

## DRAPERY TRACK

Measure from end to end and record this as your width, as shown in PIC 1.

## DRAPERY TRACKS WITH AN OVERLAP

Measure the width track (PIC 2) and add the track overlap dimension to the overall track measurement to give a final measurement. (e.g. $40^{\prime \prime}+4^{\prime \prime}+4^{\prime \prime}=48^{\prime \prime}$ ).

## About Overlaps \& Returns:

- First measure the bracket to bracket width of your window.
- Add overlap on Pleated Panels (NO OVERLAP ON GROMMETS):
- $4^{\prime \prime}$ - two-way draw pair
- $\quad 2^{\prime \prime}$ - one-way draw panel
- $0^{\prime \prime}$ - stationary panels
- Choose none (0") or $3^{\prime \prime}$ or $6^{\prime \prime}$ for returns:
- Two-way draw will be applied to outside edges
- One-way draw will be applied to draw side
- Stationary Panels will be applied to outside edges

EX: French Pleated Panels:
Window: 132"W bracket-to-bracket

- Enter your bracket to bracket measurement: 132 " W
- If you have selected pair, this must include a 4" overlap
- Choose your returns: $6^{\prime \prime}$, for pair x $2=12^{\prime \prime}$

Add these together: $132+4+12=148^{\prime \prime}$ Total Finished Width (Total Finished Width determines price)

## DRAPERY POLES

Measure between the two finials and record this as your width measurement, as shown in PIC 3. (e.g. 3 1/3").


## Measuring for your height

## GROMMET HEADING DRAPES

Measure from the top side of the pole to the desired length and record as your length measurement. Measure in three places (left, middle and right) and record the shortest measurement. (e.g. PIC 1 your measurement will be 60").

Note: Eyelet drapes will fit poles up to $1-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ grommets) or 1-7/8" (2" grommets) in diameter. The overall length will be made 1-1/8" longer to allow the drape to stand off the pole. There will always be an even number of grommets per drape.

## FRENCH PLEAT HEADING DRAPES

First decide whether you want to cover the track/pole with the drapes, or if you want the drapes to sit under the track/pole (on the ring).

Cover Track/Pole: Measure from the top of the track/pole to where you want the drapes to finish. Measure in three places and provide the shortest measurement. (e.g. PIC 1 your measurement will be 60")

Under Track: Measure from the ring or hook down to where you want the drapes to finish. Measure in three places and provide the shortest measurement (e.g. PIC 2 your measurement will be 160")

Ripple Fold: A ripple fold header needs a special track to create the ripple fold effect. The track will be visible when fitted. Measure from where the top of the track will be fitted down to your desired drop. Measure in three places and provide the shortest measurement.


## Measuring for your pole or track

Always follow the measuring and fitting instructions provided with the pole or track.

If there is space around the window, we recommend an overlap of 8 "-12" at each side and above the window (e.g. A, B, C measurements).

Note: We strongly advise you to measure and fit your track before measuring for drapes.


## Measuring for your bay window

## MEASURING THE WIDTH FOR A BAY WINDOW

## Without a track or pole in position:

If a pole or track needs to be fitted, follow the manufacturers recommendations on how to measure and fit. Each manufacturer will have slightly different instructions on measuring and fitting the track or pole.

Once the track or pole is fitted, or if you already have one in position, follow the instructions below:

## DRAPERY TRACK

Measure from end to end (PIC 1) and record this as your width measurement

## DRAPERY POLE

Measure between the two finials (PIC 2) and record this as your width measurement

Note: Not all poles for bay windows are suitable to have eyelet heading draperys. This is due to the way the pole is fixed to the wall. Please check corners/joins to ensure grommets can be fed along the pole.


# Measuring for your bay window 

## MEASURING LENGTH FOR GROMMET HEADING DRAPERIES

Measure from the top side of the pole to the desired length and record as your length measurement. Measure in three places (left, middle, and right window) and record the shortest measurement. (e.g. PIC 1 your measurement will be $60^{\prime \prime}$ ).

Note: Grommet draperys will fit poles up to $1-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter. The overall length will be made 1-1/8" longer to allow the drapery to stand off the pole. There will always be an even number of grommets per drapery.

## MEASURING LENGTH FOR PINCH PLEAT HEADING DRAPERIES

First decide whether you want to cover the track/pole with the drapery, or if you want the draperys to sit under the track/pole (on the ring).

Cover Track/Pole: Measure from the top of the track/pole to where you want the draperys to finish. Measure in three places and provide the shortest measurement. (e.g. PIC 1 your measurement will be 60").

Under Track: Measure from the ring or hook down to where you want the draperys to finish. Measure in three places and provide the smallest measurement (e.g. PIC 2 your measurement will be 60").

## General Tips

## GENERAL TIPS FOR MADE-TO-MEASURE DRAPERY

1. If you have ordered a pair, always clean them together and remove any hooks before cleaning.
2. To make your new drapery look their best, we recommend they are lightly steamed, taking care not to use exessive pressure or heat, to remove transport creases.
3. Some grommet drapery may have grommet impression marks on the fabric. If necessary, use a steamer or warm iron to remove them. Do not use excessive pressure or heat as this can distort the fabric.
4. Due to the packing methods on drapery, velvets and pile fabrics may have creasing and pressure marks which should disappear over a short time.
5. We pride ourselves on excellent quality. All drapery is inspected and photographed prior to packing and dispatching to ensure your order arrives perfectly.
6. TEXTON does not take a deduction for length on drapery. Your dimensions must be hem to hem.
7. All drapery can be professionally dry cleaned. Each drape will have a care label sewn into the side hem. Using the upholstery brush on a vacuum cleaner will help keep the draperys looking brighter and cleaner for longer.
8. All drapery are custom made to the dimensions provided at the time of ordering. Refunds and exchanges cannot be given on Made to Measure drapery that have been ordered incorrectly.

## How to Care for Roman Shades \& Drapery

## Following some simple tips to care for a shade or drapery will ensure they look at their best for longer.

## ROMAN SHADES

We recommend Roman Shades are cleaned with the upholstery brush on a vacuum cleaner. The fabric part of the shade can be dry cleaned as a last resort, please follow the below steps:

## Step 1

Ensure the fabric part of the shade is laid flat (not retracted) on a clean, flat surface.

## Step 2

Remove the fabric part of the shade from the headrail/cassette by detaching the velcro strip either on the front.

## Step 3

Turn the shade over (face side down), carefully unclip the clear plastic hooks on the cords from the plastic anchor on the shade.

## Step 4

The fabric part of the shade is now fully removed from the headrail/cassette and ready for dry cleaning.

## Step 5

To reattach, follow the same process as above in reverse. Ensure the cords are fully extended so the maximum drop is achieved.

## DRAPES

All drapes can be professionally dry cleaned. Each drape will have a care label sewn into the side hem. Using the upholstery brush on a vacuum cleaning will keep the drapes looking brighter and cleaner for longer. Linings cannot be removed for cleaning.

Adjustable Hook: All French Pleat drapes come with this adjustable hook.


Note: This product will require additional dressing and steaming after installation.

All prices are exclusive of sales tax. TEXTON reserves the right to withdraw or discontinue any product or alter the prices shown in the price list without prior notice to the customer. The piece price relates to full pieces only. Any cut length balance for orders in excess of a piece will be charged the cut length rate.

## Stock Allocation

Minimum cut $6.5^{\prime}$ in length. Goods can not be reserved. Any goods ordered on a pro-forma account are not allocated until the account is paid. Please be aware that if an account is on stop any goods allocated on a back order may be reallocated to other customers.

## Third Party Deliveries

All deliveries to a third party address must be confirmed in writing. All deliveries must be examined and signed for as accepted in good condition. If the goods are returned to us by the carrier because no one is in to accept the delivery a second delivery charge will be charged.

Faulty
Goods may be replaced at the sole discretion of the Company. Goods are supplied on condition that the liability of the Company for the fault, defect, description or fitness for the purpose is limited to an amount not exceeding their original purchase price. The Seller's liability in respect of the goods supplied shall not extend to the Buyers loss of profits, increased cost of working or any other consequential or financial losses.

## Inspection

All claims for damage, shortage, or error must be notified to the Company within 7 days of delivery. Please advise your customer/third party before cutting or third party processing. It is the responsibility of the buyer their customer or third party delivery to inspect the goods on delivery (and in any event before such goods are cut, made or hung) in respect of design, color, batch number, condition, quantity and quality. The Seller shall not be obliged to replace goods once they have been cut, made or hung.

## Returns

No goods to be returned without prior agreement. The seller reserves the right of discretion at all times to accept / refuse the return of any goods supplied. A standard handling charge of $20 \%$ plus the cost of carriage will be made for returning goods otherwise authorised. Cut or treated fabrics will not be accepted for return or credit.

## Shipping Condition

Please note, fabrics may have creases from packing. It is recommended that products be carefully steamed to ensure perfect results.

## Pattern Repeats, Joined Widths \& Pattern Alignment

Please note pattern repeats of all fabrics can vary by $+/-5 \%$, we cannot guarantee exact measurements. Please ensure that pattern alignment is adequate to produce a satisfactory result. Textiles are not completely stable. It is always possible that the pattern will not be completely `square` on the cloth. Whilst every effort is made to avoid distortion, a commercial tolerance is to be accepted. Please check the pattern alignment is acceptable before cutting and making we do not accept claims after the goods have been cut or sewn.

## Color Matching

Whilst every effort is made to ensure your order will color match the samples and pattern books we must point out that an exact match cannot be guaranteed. Should a close match be required the buyer must request a stock cutting for approval prior to ordering. Please note that none of our fabrics are guaranteed against fading

## Fabrics used as Drapes

When held against the light fabrics cannot be guaranteed to be free of visible flaws.

## Movement of Drapes In it's Original Place

All fabrics are liable to shrinkage; therefore it is important that an allowance (5\%) is allowed when making up. Atmospheric conditions such as temperature and humidity can vary. This may affect drapes when hung uncoventionally. Cellulosic yarns, viscose, or rayon and natural fibres such as cotton and linen may shrink or relax due to changes in humidity. Heavy fabrics and loose weaves may relax and lengthen. Drapes should always be made with adequate hem, loosely tacked. Side seams or attached linings should be hand slipped to allow for differential movement between face and lining fabrics. Always use a appropriate thread for the fabric you are sewing. We recommend avoiding exact length drapes, i.e Sill or floor touching and do recommend over length drapes. All drapes must be made with the possibility of making adequate adjustments in the event of any movement in the drapes. Any adjustments remain the responsibility of the maker. Movement of drapes in situ cannot be accepted as a fault in the fabric and claims will not be accepted.

## Silk \& Linens

Please note that silk and linen will contain small color variations and weave slubs, causing differentiation of densities when held against the light. This is not a defect. Silk is
unsuitable for any type of loose covering or tight upholstery. The dyes used are vegetable based and are therefore particularly vulnerable to fading in direct sunlight. Impurities in the air also cause fading. Special care should be taken to ensure that the leading edges of the drape are turned away from the window and are faced into the room. We recommend lining and interlining when making up silk drapes. Linen has a natural characteristic to crease.

## Metallic

Some of our designs have a deliberate Gold or Silver antique metallic over print. There will be variations in shade and differentiation of densities when used on any textiles such as linen or silk and any fabric with a velvet pile.

## Pocket Weave

Pocket weaves have a complex construction. Two layers of the fabric woven simultaneously and joined with the chenille / cotton yarn to create the design of the fabric. This technique gives a slightly quilted look to finished drapes which is characteristic of this construction. We recommend a sample is always requested prior to ordering.

## Sheers \& Voiles

Fully joining the widths is not recommended. The normal accepted way is to join the widths at the top of the tape, to weight the bottom and to leave the drops loose and not sewn together.

## Flocks, Velvets \& Pile Fabrics

The rolls of fabric should not be dropped or stored on end as permanent creasing will result. All textured or pile fabrics may flatten. Piles may distort.
Slight color variations may occur between each batch
Title of Goods \& Copyright

## Washing \& Cleaning

The obligation of Texton, Inc. is limited to repair or replace the shadings or components found to be defective, and excludes shipping charges and labor costs for measuring, fabricating and installation. Repairs will be made with like or similar parts. ## Child Safety

Our Shades are designed with child safety as a priority. To reduce the risk of strangulation, our fabrication methods incorporate features to comply with the current ANSI cord safety standard. Fabrication methods include breakaway cord stops, Cord-Shield cording, and tension devices.

To further reduce the risk of accidents, all cords should be kept out of reach of children. Cord cleats can help implement this essential precaution and are therefore included with all standard cord lock/pull cord Roller Shade products.

For Roller Shades made with a clutch operating system our tension device is designed and is to be placed and shipped so that, unless it is properly installed (or altered from the shipped condition with sequential process or tools), the tension device prevents the shade from operating. The tension device once installed can help prevent children from pulling cords around their necks.

## Motionshade Motorization Warranty

Coulisse's Motion Motors offers a 3 year warranty on all motors and controls. Specifically, Coulisse warrants its motors and controls to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal and proper use for a period of 3 years commencing with the date stamped on each product.
